



DevMountain is proud to be a part of CIRR and are fully committed to reporting outcomes beginning with our 2017 cohorts.

Previous to joining CIRR, DevMountain always collected outcome information on full-time graduates and their employment status (including whether they were in-field and what company they were employed at). With the depth of information needed to report in accordance with CIRR standards, we evaluated our methods in gathering outcomes data and made a plan to collect data that would be acceptable under CIRR standards. In an effort to promote transparency and report our data thus far, we attempted to re-poll every graduate from January-June 2016 in order to get as much CIRR-ready data as possible. We began this re-polling process one month ago.

Unfortunately, in our short time frame, we were only able to collect information for 103 of 177 graduates, which equates to less than a 60% response rate. We made five attempts to contact and collect data from graduates including outreach via email, text, phone and instant messaging. Due to the timeframe and lack of responses, we are unable to report these numbers at this time.

We have created new systems that are being implemented immediately in order to track all outcomes according to CIRR guidelines. We are confident in the outcomes of our graduates and look forward to sharing this information in the future.

We will continue to collect information regarding July - December 2016, however we are committed to reporting CIRR standard outcomes starting with the graduates from January – June 2017.
